Texas Brain and Spine Institute Receives Grant

BRYAN, TX – The Texas Brain and Spine Institute has received an unsolicited grant from the Brain Tumor Foundation, Inc. to fund neurosciences research. Lowell V. Hammer, Vice President of the Board of Directors of the Brain Tumor Foundation, awarded the \$5,000 grant on behalf of the Friends of BTF - in memory of BTF Founder Christopher Allen Hammer.

“This was an unsolicited grant from a Foundation that cares very deeply about advancing the care of neurological conditions, particularly brain tumor treatment,” said Dr. Jonathan Friedman, a neurosurgeon with the TBSI. “It reminds us how important research advancement is in the lives of patients and their friends and families.”

The TBSI is a multidisciplinary collaboration between St. Joseph Regional Health Center, a group of more than 20 neuroscience specialists, and the neuroscience research programs at the Texas A&M Health Science Center College of Medicine. The Institute is a center of excellence in neuroscience, providing a network of clinical and academic resources that offers state of the art diagnostic and treatment services for neurological disorders, while at the same time furthering neuroscience research.
