ABSTRACT SUBMISSION GUIDELINES:

All abstracts should be formatted according to the following guidelines and must be submitted to Dr. Nancy Leslie (dr.leslie@bvpo.com) or online at <http://www.txbsi.com/symposium/abstract.php>.

• Abstracts must contain the following in this order: Abstract Title, Authors, Affiliations, and main text:

- **Title** (typed in ALL CAPS) cannot exceed 150 characters (including spaces). The abstract title should be as concise as possible
- **Author(s)** – do not include degree acronyms (i.e., BS, MS, PhD, etc) or credentials (CSCS, etc). Authors' names should be listed with initials of first names only followed by the last names in full. Authors should be separated by commas. Center the author list and put an * after the presenting author. Add a blank line before the author list. Indicate up to 6 authors only; if more than 6 use 'et al'.
- **Affiliation** (Institution / Laboratory Name, City, State). Affiliations should follow on the next line without a blank line. As noted above, the maximum level of detail should be the name of the organization, institute or department and country. Full street addresses should not be included. Affiliations should be italicized. Superscript numbers should be used as a key to affiliate names to organizations. Numbers should appear after the authors' names and then before each affiliation. Center the affiliations.
- **Abstract** Leave a blank line before the main abstract text and use Times Roman font in 11 pt size, single line spacing, lower case, bold, and full justification. The abstract should be no longer than 400 words. Left and right page margins should be set at 3.17 cm each.

It should contain the following information: Introduction, Methods, Results and Conclusions. Acknowledgements should be included to denote funding sources or conflicts of interest when applicable. Do not type "abstract" at the start of the main text. Leave a single blank line between paragraphs. Justify paragraphs and do not indent the first time. Inclusion of embedded figures is accepted. Figures should be of good quality and high resolution. Figures should be embedded in the main text file.
